Starting this month, we are going to do a short feature on a new member in each issue of the JCSC newsletter. Our member for April is Colin Schmeisser.

1. Please tell us about yourself.

My partner Rachel and I live in Black Forest, CO. I am the President of the Engineering and Technical Services Business Group for Akima LLC, which is a government contracting company headquartered in Herndon, VA. I grew up in Santa Barbara, CA, attending UCLA and went into the Air Force after graduation. I was in the communications-electronics career field and enjoyed assignments as far ranging as England And Alaska, and many points in between. I retired from the USAF in 1995 and have lived in Colorado ever since. I have two grown kids, a son and a daughter, both of whom live in Iowa. We enjoy outdoor activities here in Colorado such as hiking, camping, fishing and skiing, but my primary hobby is restoring cars.

2. What is your interest in British sports cars?

My older brother got me hooked on British cars when I was 10. I would help him work on his cars (Rover, MG, Sprite) in the garage and he taught me about cars and tools. We would go to the SCCA road races in Santa Barbara and I developed a lifelong interest in British cars. My first car was an English Ford Cortina which I rallied and slalomed and I hav gone on to won and restore a 1959 Rover, 1960 Bugeye Sprite, 1962 MG Midget, 1972 Jaguar XJ6 and am currently restoring a 1966 MGB. My 1967 Jaguar 420 is next in line for restoration! I have a 3 bay workshop next to my house and do all my own mechanical, body, paint and upholstery work. I enjoy going to vintage racing events and each year I make the annual pilgrimage in August to Monterey CA for the Rolex historic car races and to see the auctions.

3. Why did you join the Jaguar Club of Southern Colorado?

I recently acquired the 1967 Jaguar 420 and wanted to meet and get to know other Jaguar enthusiasts. I also know that restoring a top-end car involves establishing a network of reliable sources for parts and services and I knew that I could benefit from the experiences of other local Jaguar owners in finding good technical advice. I also wanted to enjoy the "Jaguar Experience" with social activities, concours and other club activities and to meet friends with similar interests.

4. What Jaguar(s) do you own and when did you buy it/them?

I owned an XJ6 when I was stationed in England in the '70s and from that experience decided that I wanted to restore a mid to late '60s Jaguar sedan. That was intended to be my next car acquisition and project after my MGB was finished. I put some "search filters" in place with Hemmings and e-bay, just to see what the market was like for a MKII, 3.8S or a 420 - - price ranges, availability, etc. I figured I was a year or so away from seriously searching. Then one Saturday last April I got an automatic email from e-bay showing a '67 420 for sale in Culpepper, Virginia with all the options I wanted, Jaguar heritage certificate and low miles! It seemed too good to pass up so I talked to the seller, did some research, examined all the pictures he sent and decided to go for it. I put a ridiculously low bid on the car and ended up winning the auction! It has been stored and off the road for several years, but running. I drove it from the transporter into my workshop and now it's awaiting restoration!

5. Why did you buy the Jaguars that you currently own?

I think the late '60s Jaguars were some of the best motor cars ever built. They had true styling, craftsmanship, good materials and great performance without the constraints of emission controls, heavy safety bumpers, etc. An E-Type would have been my first choice, but those now command prices well out of my range so I began looking for a sedan. The 420 has much of the same running gear of the E-Type but with a comfortable 4-door body style and at a far lower price.

6. Do you plan on buying any additional Jaguars in the near future?

If I stumble across an affordable E-Type I'll jump on it!

7. What do you want to get out of being in the Jaguar Club of Southern Colorado?

I'm looking forward to the opportunity to make new friends, spend a little time socializing with other Jaguar lovers, swapping technical and restoration tips and to participate in and attend some fun car events!

8. Is there anything else you would like the club membership to know about you and/or your cars?

I've always enjoyed the "workshop time" during a restoration as much as finally driving the car. I get great satisfaction from taking a broken down, rusty car and bringing it back to it's glory with my hands. I am a pretty practical person and own a Subaru Forester as a daily driver and a Ford Expedition to do my hauling and towing. I'm always available to give some car advice or lend a hand if someone has an issue with their vehicle.


