The January 2013 club event was a joint gathering of JCSC and RMJC members and guests. Lunch was at The Airplane Restaurant adjacent to Peterson Air Force Base in Colorado Springs.

Dining at the Airplane Restaurant is a unique experience as the main dining room is located inside a KC-97 tanker aircraft. The left wing of the KC-97 extends into the "normal" dining areas and the entire





establishment is full of models of aircraft in various scales and a huge collection of military and civilian aviation related memorabilia.

The Airplane Restaurant was an excellent prelude to the tour of the National Museum of WW-II Aviation that followed our lunch.

The National Museum of World War II Aviation is the only museum in the world to focus solely on the unique roll of aviation in World War II.



An extremely knowledgeable tour guide escorted our members through the "Time Line" portion of the museum and then into WestPac Restorations display and shop areas.

WestPac Restorations is one of the foremost restoration companies of World War II aircraft. This company is a state-of-the-art restoration facility that includes a Federal Aviation Administration approved propeller repair station and one of the largest and most complete metal working and forming shops in the country. They have the equipment and technical know-how to completely restore World War II vintage aircraft to full flying condition.

With the tools and talent available here, one couldn't help but contemplate what a fantastic place this would be to completely restore a Jaguar!

The National Museum of WWII Aviation provides a unique educational experience to promote a deeper understanding of the historical importance of American aviation in the Second World War.




