SHELBY AMERICAN MUSEUM

The Shelby American Collection is a journey into the heritage of America's greatest racing car.



The displayed vehicles range from an original AC Bristol through the GT-40's of Le Mans racing legend. Included are 289 and 427 Cobra's, GT-350 and GT-500 Cobras and even a Sunbeam Tiger. A Ferrari 410 Sport Scaglieitti Spider driven by Carroll Shelby and other period notable drivers such as Phil Hill and Richie Ginther is also included in the collection. A fine exhibit of very detailed model racing cars is also displayed. Associated Shelby

racing memorabilia is scattered throughout the museum.

**Heartland Vintage Racing
(update)**

Heartland Vintage Racing (HVR) is the newest Vintage Racing Organization and will present its very first event August 19-20-21-22 of 2010 at Heartland Park Topeka, Topeka, Kansas.

[O'Reilly Auto Parts](#) company is the proud sponsor of this Vintage Racing Extravaganza and is excited about the many things involved such as:

The featured Marque is Triumph and The Friends of Triumph and others will have a great opportunity to support the Kastner Cup Race which will be the featured race on Sunday, August 22. This race will begin with a band playing the National Anthem and a great fly over.

Leading up to the Sunday races which include all of the normal Groups plus the Victory Lane Vintage Formula Vee Festival Race, will be a Performance Driving Experience (PDX) on Thursday in conjunction with race car Test and Tune. There are 8 Groups of race cars and they will be racing all of Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

For only \$100 you can enter the PDX with your own street or race car and you will have a licensed race driver assigned to you as an instructor. Class room in the morning, followed by the rest of the day on track, learning to drive your car to the best of your ability and the best of the car's ability.

Friday evening the Heartland Park Topeka Paddock will hold an Open House for the public to come in and see the race cars and visit with the Drivers, Crew Members, Car Club Members and Vendors.

The Topeka High School Band Cheer Leaders will be providing a car wash in the paddock to offset some of their band expenses.

Car clubs will grace a large area of the paddock in a huge corral and vintage race cars such as Indy Roadsters and Classic and Exotic race cars etc. will be on display in prominent areas. These cars will also be performing on track. There will also be well over 50 vendors in the vendor row.

At this time it is expected that well over 5000 spectators will be in attendance. Guest rooms have been blocked out at the Ramada Convention Center, Downtown Topeka (HVR headquarters) as well as at the Holiday Inn and the Holiday Inn Express.

INVITATION TO CAR CLUBS

Now is the time to be planning your car club events for the rest of this year. So many things to do and only a few months to do them in. Why not make at least one of those events an EXCITING EXTRAVAGANZA that your members will always remember.

Heartland Vintage Racing with sponsorship from O'Reilly Auto Parts company will have a very major Vintage Race Event at Heartland Park Topeka in Topeka, Kansas during August 19-20-21-22 of 2010.

There will be a huge area for the Car Club Corral within the Paddock area. Club members will be able to walk among the race cars and visit with the drivers and crew members. Watch the old cars (1972 and older) run the way they used to run. Eight groups of cars will run, one group immediately after another, all day long. See displays of old Indy Roadsters and others and watch those same cars as they turn exhibition laps on the 2.5 mile road course. Enjoy the song of the Offy's. Any one of three huge earthen hills on three sides of the entire course. Get close to the noise and the action on the grass area near turn 11 while you enjoy the hot dogs etc. from the nearby concession stand.

Visit all of the 50 or more vendors in vendor row including a large O'Reilly Auto Parts display. Listen to the band and its drum corps as they play the National Anthem on race Sunday while aircraft fly over this huge facility.

Want to participate in the action? Come early and enter the Performance Driving Experience (PDX) on August 19. This event only costs \$100 and provides some classroom in the morning and then driving your own car on track the rest of the day. A licensed race car driver will be assigned to you as an instructor and he will bring you up to speed to the best of your ability and the cars ability. You will need to bring a 2000 spec or later helmet.

The Vintage Race Cars (about 200 or more of them) will be participating in test and tune on Thursday with practice and races on Friday and then races are all day on Saturday and Sunday. Sunday morning will rise and shine with the Bumble Bee Buzz of Vintage Formula V's in the Victory Lane Vintage Formula Vee Festival race that we expect 50 to 60 cars to participate in.

Just after lunch on Sunday we will hold the Kastner Cup Race which features only Triumph race cars. A huge turnout of entries is expected for this annual Triumph event. This race will be honored with a special aircraft fly over.

Your car club corral entry does not cost extra. Only a daily \$10 admission charge per person will apply. A three day pass will be available for \$25. Your corral spot will be marked off and a sign will indicate your clubs name. All we need is descriptive information about your club and the number of cars that will participate. Please complete the Car Club Application form (under the Forms button on our website) to secure your reservation. Mail to: Heartland Vintage Racing, 116 Flynn Road, Suite A, Branson, MO 65616.

We do suggest that your members arrive on Thursday the 19th or no later than during the day on the 20th. Arrive on the 18th if they wish to participate in the PDX.
