The Endurance Rally Association, headquartered in Oxon, England (www.endurorally.com), began organizing rallies with the first being the Pirelli Classic Marathon in 1988 which ran from London to Italy.

The ERA organized the first Peking to Paris rally in 1997. This rally was held to commemorate the

Around the World New York to Paris race of 1907. Using a route that ran through Tibet, crossing the Himalayas and camping at the foot of Mount Everest, the race continued through India and Pakistan and included the first crossing of Iran to conclude in Paris. The 10,000 mile rally has been held again in 2007, 2010 and is scheduled again in 2012.

The Endurance Rally Association marked the Millenium with the "Around the World in 80 Days" rally. This event ran from London's Tower Bridge overland to China, used an airlift to reach Alaska and ran across Canada and the U.S. to New York. Using another air lift to Monaco the rally continued overland back to Tower Bridge in London.

Other ERA events include a London to Athens rally in 2002, a 2005 London to Dakar rally, won by a Peugeot 205. Upcoming ERA rallies include the April 2013 Flying Scotsman London to Edinburgh drive, and a November 2013 Vintage Cape Horn trip.


