From The President

Have you ever thought about why there are car or other "special interest" clubs? Most experts agree the reasons include meeting other people with similar interests, participating in activities such as social events, tours, rallies, drive-in's, concours and slaloms, learning more about your marquee and specific model of car(s) and performing community service activities. Other reasons include periodic credits towards the purchase or lease of new automobiles and discounts on parts, service, apparel and accessories at Jaguar Colorado Springs (see page 3 in this issue).

In my opinion, here are the top five reasons to join up:

1. You are likely to meet a bunch of people who are fundamentally just like you. Chances are you'll have a lot to talk about and will end up making friends.

2. The internet is a useful tool for research and discussion, but friends on the other side of the country can't help you work on your brakes or give you a ride to pick up your Jaguar from the repair shop.

3. You can get access to specialty tools through your club as in the JCNA Tool Loan Program. If one member has a car lift in his shop, chances are you can borrow it from time to time. Then you can spend your budget on another tool that no one else has yet. Be sure to share!

4. Finding a group of like-minded people in your area will help you keep your interest in your car. This is especially true if your car is a project that may take some time before it's ready to drive.

5. The other members of the club know where to shop for parts, which shops to use and have probably seen and overcome every challenge you will face. Their experience may or may not be available on the internet forums.

So, why did you join JCSC? Hopefully, your reasons go beyond, "I received a free membership from Thom Buckley when I bought my Jaguar at the local dealership!"

I also strongly believe the club plays a critical part in this experience. The club should provide the structure, resources and activities that meet the needs of the membership. However, the leadership needs to know what you want to do and, quite frankly, we do not receive much feedback. We send out a survey at the end of each calendar year soliciting input and get very few responses. We try to offer varied activities. So far this year, we have conducted dinners, a museum visit and a parade and on June 1st, the club will be the host for the First and Main First Saturday Car Show followed by a club potluck and test driving of the new F-Type at the dealership. Are we on the mark or not? I don't know – this is your call not mine. Think about why you joined JCSC and let me or any of the board members know what you think we should be doing.






