Minutes of the February 15, 2011 meeting

The meeting was called to order at 7:04 P.M. by Gary Kerkow.

Dues Information: Thom provided a new membership roster. Five members have not yet paid, the club has paid for one member and we have one honorary member. Gary inquired about new Membership Cards. Thom said we did not necessarily need new cards and the Club discount was in effect with the existing cards.

Gary: The AGM will be in March. No one from our Club is attending so Gary will contact Deannie Kennedy regarding a delegate from the RMJC representing our Club.

Gary received a note from Jim Verhey requesting any old automobile magazines be mailed to our troops overseas. A mailing address will be posted on the Club website or distributed via email.

The upcoming tour of the Goodwood Revival and other automotive related attractions in England in September was discussed. Details will be included in the February newsletter. There is also a 50th Anniversary E-Type celebration being held in San Francisco June 10, 11 and 12.

Saint Patrick's Day Parade information: The parade begins at 12:00 P.M. Staging details will be available in March. This is the first year for our Club to be involved in this parade. So far, we only have 4 vehicles available and we need 8 or 9 plus we need someone to carry a JCSC banner and possibly hand out candy (no throwing candy permitted). We need a "Statement of Purpose" for our Club and proof of insurance for each vehicle entered in the parade.

Events: The May event is the tour and meeting at ReinCARnation. We do not have June event yet. July is the RMJC Concours in Palmer Lake

Matt Grimes has a new job. We may need to find a new Web Master. Thom mentioned Gene Smith (he has renewed this year). Thom will contact him to see if he is interested in setting up a day drive and lunch destination event.

Treasurer's Report: Present balance is \$3705.46.

Larenda suggested we send Jack H. a "care package".

The meeting was adjourned at 7:55 P.M. and the Concours Committee meeting began immediately after.

The Club also needs to make sure we arrange for assistance with the British Motoring Festival for Thom. The British Motoring Festival is an integral part of the Concours so the Club needs to include this in our planning.
