Minutes of the July 19, 2011 meeting

The meeting was called to order by Gary K. at 7:00 P.M.

Gary related that the Inn at Palmer Divide was a nice venue and would be a good place for a dinner drive destination. Over 30 cars were entered in the Concours and the overall outcome was nice.

Larenda announced we picked up some new members from the Concours; Steve and Marti Sletta. They have a Mk I Jaguar Saloon.

Gary read the letter that the JCSC received from Jaguar Cars relating to a copyright and trademark agreement that we must agree to in order to continue to utilize the Jaguar name and the Leaper trademark. The club members present agreed that we should sign and submit the agreement. A copy will be retained in the JCSC archives.

JCNA is looking for a Host Club for Western States 2012. The desired location would be Phoenix, AZ or Reno, NV. There is discussion of combining the Western States 2012 program with the JCNA 2012 AGM.

September 10 will be the Shelby American Museum drive with lunch again at the Baker Street Pub and Grill. Don Y. will handle the arrangements.

September 17 and 18 will be the British Motoring Conclave in Arvada. Details will be forthcoming.
