During the rallye you will experience Colorado's amazing scenery, from the mighty Arkansas River Valley to the breathtaking vistas of the Sangre de Cristo Mountain range, culminating with a cruise past the largest active gold mine in North America.


Upon reaching the Wildwood Casino, your final destination in Cripple Creek, there will be ample time to try your luck at the gaming tables or enjoy one of the many unique tourist attractions. The day wraps up with cocktails and dinner followed by the awards ceremony, where autographed Michael Garman sculptures will be provided to the best and worst rallye teams. Additionally, each rally team will receive commemorative number roundels for their car and a unique Gold Belt Rallye plate as a collector's item.

Never done a rallye before? Don't worry, we'll have a pre-rally session to explain the details of this fun event. If rallying isn't your thing, we have a self-guided driving tour to Cripple Creek as an option or if you want to sit back, relax, and let someone else do the driving, we have made arrangements so you can take the Ramblin' Express bus to Cripple Creek.
