Budd Butcher's 1965 E -Type Roadster

This is somewhat of a condensed version of my Jaguar restoration story. I believe I had to replace, restore or adjust just about every piece of functional equipment on the car. I'll give you a few highlights.



The exercise started in June 1999 when I happened to see an E-Type Jaguar roadster sitting in a used car lot. I had owned two E-Types previously and enjoyed driving and tinkering with the cars, so this sighting got my attention.



Looking it over it appeared to be all there, but in very rough condition (little did I know how rough!). The paint was crazed and chipped. The original color was BRG but the next layer red and finally blue. The interior was completely shot, seats, carpets and the dash were torn and cracked, the windshield broken and some switches missing. Driving it didn't get better. Brakes worked

only with vigorous pumping, the exhaust emitted a lot of blue smoke and the clutch throw-out bearing was next to useless. I should have walked away at that point, but any semblance of rational thinking completely left me: I was hooked!



After getting the car home, the tear-down began. Dead mice were found under the carpets, popcorn in the air filter canister, leaking radiator and gas tank. It was a depressing situation and I knew that with, engine, interior and exterior restoration to look forward to it was not going to get better. However, this time I was determined to bring it back to life.

The engine and power train came first. I

had the car towed to the shop for engine removal and brought back to my garage so I could work on various electrical and mechanical components of the car. I sent the exhaust manifolds out for high temperature ceramic coating and intake manifold, valve covers and carburetor posted to a professional polishing service. I stripped the interior and sent the components to a trim shop and after cleaning the interior base, I installed custom soundproofing.

Next I installed a new windshield (it took two tries to get one to me in one piece). The installation took all day, much frustration, bruised knuckles and thoughts like "why have I done this to myself?" I thought the windshield installation was bad but the gas tank removal took the



prize as "most difficult task". I think the English built the car around the gas tank. It took considerable



research, phone calls and tenacity to get it out of the trunk. The electrical system took time, but once I figured out the color codes and wiring diagrams I managed to get the entire electrical system functional. The speedometer was inoperative so I sent it out for cleaning and


calibration. At the same time I removed the clock and had it repaired. The battery compartment was a mess: new parts and fiberglass repair was necessary to secure that area.

Finally the engine was ready for installation. Both the top and bottom of the engine was done, so essentially I now have a new engine. With the engine installed, test drives could begin. Only a few blocks at a time because something needed repair or adjustment every time I took it out. It was now ready for paint. I selected an Emerald Green rather than BRG as it gives it a little more class. That process took three months. Following that the remainder of the interior and top was installed. I now have a good driving and nice looking E-Type Jaguar.

The guy who sold me the car can't believe the transformation - he was impressed! But probably the best return for all my work was comments by my neighbors. Many who would come by to harass and question my sanity for taking on the project now come to ogle at the final results and apologize for their previously tacky remarks.

SUBJECT: Lightweight E-type Re-creation

INTRODUCTION

In 1963 Jaguar began a production run of 18 special Lightweight E-type racecars; only 12 of the 18 were produced, the last being delivered in 1964. This left 6 chassis numbers dormant for the next 50 years. Now, the Heritage division of Jaguar is going to build the last six remaining Lightweight racing E-types.

DETAILS

- Jaguar is building six brand new 'Lightweight' E-types the 'missing' six Lightweights that were never built from the original intended 18-car series.
- This is the first ever 're-creation' project from Jaguar; the alkaluminum cars will be assigned the six remaining chassis numbers which were originally allocated in 1963.
- All six vehicles will be built as reproductions and to the specifications of the original 12 cars first
 produced in 1963.
- The new cars will be hand-built in-house by Jaguar. Each car will be constructed to the specifications of their original 1960s forebears, including the 3.8-liter straight-six engine.
- The original Lightweight cars weighed approximately 25 olb less than a standard E-type, thanks to an all-aluminum body and engine block, a lack of interior and exterior trim and a host of further weight-saving features.
- The first new Lightweight E-type will make its public debut later this summer; further information
 will be released at that point.
- Information on global allocation to markets around the world has not been released at this time;
 for additional information please contact Derek Wealeat the number or email below.
- . As a racecar, any Lightweight E-type imported into the US will not be street legal.

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
